



Andria McClellan for Senate and Kim Sudderth for Delegate Announce Joint Endorsements

Norfolk, VA - Two current Norfolk leaders, and respective candidates for the Virginia Senate and the Virginia House of Delegates, announced today their joint endorsements. Andria McClellan, a candidate for the Virginia Senate (SD-21) serves on the Norfolk City Council, representing half of the city in Superward 6; and, Kim Sudderth, a candidate for the Virginia House of Delegates (HD-92) serves as the Vice Chair of the Norfolk Planning Commission.

This announcement comes just shy of three months before early voting begins for the June 20th Democratic primary election.

Andria McClellan is a Norfolk City Councilmember who represents half of Norfolk in Superward 6. She is the Chair of the Southside Network Authority and a board member of the Elizabeth River Trail Foundation, 757 Angels, UVA's Sorensen Institute for Political Leadership and the CIVIC Leadership Institute. Andria is a past Chair of the Hampton Roads Planning District Commission and Hampton Roads Transit (HRT), and she is a member of the Ghent Neighborhood League and Christ & St. Luke's Episcopal Church.

Kim Sudderth is the Vice-Chair of the Norfolk Planning Commission, the Environmental and Climate Justice Chair of the Norfolk NAACP, and an Environmental Justice Fellow at the University of Virginia. She is also a member of the Beacon Light Civic League and the Berkley Historical Society.
